Announcement: Next Work Trip to Haiti

Dear KBR supporters,

Hopefully all of our supporters had the chance to [read our report for the last work trip in March](#). If you didn't, I encourage you to do that now. BIG THANKS to all of you who sent prayers and good energy for me. Thank you all so much for the love!

July will make four months since the last work trip. I am already planning my next work trip to Haiti. This time I will have with me Erin Danford, one of KBR's board members. Erin is going to Haiti for one week, and we are very excited about it. She will be working on a documentary that will talk about the difficulties the street collectors are facing while doing their work. We've been talking about the way these women are being made fun of, and ridiculed all day long. We are going to start to bring attention to the issue and find ways to continue educating the public so they value the cleanup that is creating a cleaner environment for all of us.

In addition, I will continue what I did not have the chance to finish from my last trip due to the accident and the government strike. In the July trip, my focus will be in:

1. Installing the generator that was shipped to Haiti last March. I was not able to do the installation because the generator did not make it through customs in March due to a government strike.
2. Looking for the land that we have been talking about for years now. It's getting to a point where we are in desperate need for the land. KBR's lease ends in 12 months or so, and our goal is to have our own location that will be more permanent.
3. Meeting with the school teachers who teach Kay Blada's education program. I am bringing with me more educational material for the 5 schools that are in the "environmental education" program. It is very exciting because we are going to talk about what worked and what didn't. We are going to discuss ways to make the program more effective.
